

Thank you for entering our race meeting to be held at Lithgow City Raceway.

- You will find the Supplementary Regulations, Race Order, Pit Allocations, Entry Lists and Timetables on CDKC Facebook and the CDKC website, after the close of entries. www.cdkc.com.au Please check your **race number, transponder number and class** details are correct. If any changes are to be considered, we need to know before Sunday morning.
- Please be mindful that the published schedule is a guide. If we are ahead of time, we will continue to stay ahead of time.
- The track will be open for Practice Friday and Saturday prior 9.00am to 4.00pm. **You must “Sign-on” and pay for practice electronically before coming to the track** via the CDKC website <https://www.cdkc.com.au/practice-sign-on/> we run practice to a timetable in organised groups on Saturday.
- **Sign on for Saturday Practice must be completed by 8.00am Saturday. The Practice fee will increase by \$20.00 after 8.00am. Race transponder and numbers to be fitted Saturday.** If after signing on to practice, you then choose not to go on track on Saturday, we will refund your sign on fee.
- **Saturday Practice will be controlled from the timing box. Safety light system will be in operation for Saturday. If you receive a flag that requires you to see and official, go to the timing box. Failing to obey the control flags or practice conditions may result in practice exclusions or grid penalties.**
- All race tyres will be scanned and checked throughout the event. we would like to have initial scanning done on SATURDAY, from 12.00pm at the tech shed. If you are not able to have your tyres done Saturday, please be sure to present for scanning 15 minutes before your qualifying session.
- Engines and restrictors (if relevant) will be sealed prior to qualifying. This can be done Saturday from 3.00pm at the tech shed. Seals must be fitted in accordance with the diagram available on the CDKC Website and social media.
- TAG Restricted competitors must select the weigh/restrictor type before their engine is sealed. Those using a larger restrictor will be supplied an identifier that must be fitted to the front number plate.
- If you have damaged or incorrectly fitted your tags and need replacements, there is a fee of \$10.00 to pay via this link <https://www.cdkc.com.au/about-us/payments/> You will receive an email conformation of payment. The must be shown to the scrutineer before replacement seals will be issued
- If an on track issue has occurred that the officials have not instigated action on and you wish us to review the circuit footage, you will be required to lodge a completed protest form and pay the protest fee via the CDKC website <https://www.cdkc.com.au/about-us/payments/> . After review of the footage, if officials determine an obvious breach of the rules and take action based on this, your protest fee will be refunded. If the officials do not determine and obvious breach based on the Circuit footage your protest will be forwarded to the event Stewards and take the normal course of action.
- Start procedure will follow the KNSW rules M2.20, please make yourself aware of your responsibilities. We would urge you to read the Start Procedure Information on the club website <https://www.cdkc.com.au/about-us/rolling-start-procedure/>
- There will be a start briefing after qualifying at the base of the control tower, this is compulsory for grid 1 & 2 and recommended for any other competitor. Check the race schedule for times.
- Please make sure you understand the use of the Cut through and Yellow Arrow

- P plater's must have their karts Scrutineered, this can be done Saturday afternoon or Sunday morning at 7.00am, near the out-grid entry.
- Please **drive slowly and quietly** once you have crossed the rail line on Oakey Forest Road and always respect the local residence privacy.

Drivers briefing @ 7.30am on the out grid, Qualifying will start at 8.00am Sunday.
